Mission: The purpose of Sts. Peter & Paul PTO is fourfold:

While the mission statement from our bylaws describes what drives our organization, the nuts and bolts of our work are 1) organizing our much-needed parent volunteers for the various events and activities surrounding SPPS, and 2) promoting many of the fundraising projects that sustain a variety of aspects of school life.

Membership: Sts. Peter & Paul PTO is open to all parents and guardians of students enrolled at SPPS; the faculty and staff are members by virtue of their position. Membership enrollment is held at the beginning of each school year, and there are no membership dues. All requests for funds exceeding \$750 are subject to approval by the General Assembly. Nominations for and the election of new board members are conducted in the spring for the following school year.

Meetings: The PTO conducts meetings on the second Tuesday of each month at 6:00 pm in the Elementary Library (basement) throughout the academic year. These meetings are open to all SPPS parents, faculty, and staff wishing to attend.
